3. Competition entry conditions and provisional program

This competition is governed by the International Working Equitation WAVE Program.

The schedules are given on an indicative basis, the exact timetable will be shared just before the event.

Arrival of horses and riders is individual. Last arrival is the 8th of September at 11:00.

The parking zone for lorries and horse boxes will be close to the stables.

The stables will be guarded 24 hours a day from Monday, September 7th to Monday, September 14th. Give Horse Passport, veterinary documents and your music to the organizers as soon as you arrive.

- 12h-14h: Vet Check by alphabetical order of your country and competitors' number (bib), the president of the judges, the president of the appeal committee and the WAVE delegate will be present during this inspection.
- 15:00: Meeting of the judge's panel.
- 16:00-20:00: Sound check, warm-up in riding arena (Familiarization): 15 minutes per country in alphabetical order of country.

- 10h00-19h00: Dressage Test Part 1.

Thursday, September 10

- 10h00-19h00: Dressage Test Part 2.
- 19h00: Award ceremony for individual and team Dressage events.

Friday, September 11

- 10h00-19h00: EOH test.
- 19h00: Award ceremony for the individual and team EOH events.

Saturday, September 12

- 12:00 – 17:00: Speed test.
- 17:00: Award ceremony for the individual and team Speed events.
- 18:00: The individual award ceremony.
- 21:00: Gala closing party.

- 09:00: Draw of the cattle for the Cow test.
- 10:00-16:30: Cow test.
- 17:00: Award ceremony for the teams.
- 18:00: Final award ceremony.

- Competition arena:

- Definition of the running order:

Dressage: Draw at 16h00 on Tuesday, 08 of September after the judges panel meeting.

Handling and speed tests: The running order is defined by international WAWE rules.

Cow trial/Cow test: The draw will take place on the Sunday morning.

All draws will take place in the presence of the team leaders, the WAWE delegate, the president of the competition and the appeal judges.

6. Invitations:

This championship is only open to countries with WAWE affiliated organizations (with valid protocol) and entries are made through these organizations.

6.1 **Teams:**

Number of riders: Each country can compete with individual riders (maximum of 2) or in teams, minimum of 3 riders, maximum of 4 riders.

6.2 **Entries:**

Entry fees: 550€ including the entry fee and the stables (from Monday, 07 to Monday, 14), the first bed, The Gala party for each rider and for the team leader is included in the fee.

Included 4 accreditation per rider and one for the Chief Team per country.

Tack Box:

6.3 **Equipment liabilities:**

The organization committee is not responsible for any damage caused to your vehicles, horse boxes, material, tack Box accessorizes or other objects that may be lost or stolen. We are not responsible for any tack left in the horse boxes provided as a tack room.

6.4 **Horses safety:**

Access to the stables will be restricted to the competition organizers, riders and grooms.

Members of the security team can ask for identification before accessing the stables. A wristband to access the stables will be given to you on arrival.

7. Commitment dates:

- **Precommitment:** May the 20th, to know if the country is taking part in the competition
- **Final commitment:** June the 16th, to know how many riders are taking part & payment of the entry fees.
- **Nominative commitment:** August the 04th.

8. Veterinary rules:

All horses must have identification papers from their country of origin. This document must be shown on arrival at the event.

All horses must be vaccinated against flu and equine rhinopneumonitis abiding FEI rules. The horse must be tested laboratory for infectious anemia of the horse EIA; this examination must not be older than 12 months.

Horses must have TRACES - this document is also necessary. This document will be issued to you by your veterinary office based on the control of your horse by your veterinarian.

Please inquire about transport / export rules and documentation in your country. Any veterinary costs due to these rules have an additional fee.

9. Anti-doping rules:

Anti-doping tests by blood sampling or/and urine tests may be carried out during the whole event.

10. Claims:

Abiding international rules, any claims have to be written in English, submitted to the president of the judges panel along with a deposit. The 150€ deposit will only be refunded if the claimant is successful and the claim valid.

11. Ceremonies:

Awards after each event:

The award ceremony for the 4 part of championship will take place at the end of each part, with the 5 first riders on horseback.

The individual award ceremony will take place on Saturday, September 12 at the end of the day, with all the riders and their horses.

The team award ceremony will take place on Sunday, September 13 at the end of the day, with all the teams and their horses.

12. Gala dinner:

Saturday, September 12.

This meal is included in the entrance fee for each rider and for any team leader that has entered the competition. It is possible to book this Gala dinner for people who did not compete, the price is 100€ per person. Last day to pay for the Gala Dinner on August 5th.

Reservations made after that date are not guaranteed.

13. Insurance:

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for the damages caused to third parties, by themselves, employees, agents or horses and they are accordingly most strongly advised to take out civil liability insurance, fully covering their participation in Trials in their own country or abroad and that such insurance policy must be kept up to date. The organizing committee is not responsible by third parties if a competitor does not have a valid insurance policy. Horses and competitors' equipment remain under the riders / owner's responsibility. Competitors are responsible for all costs resulting from accidents. Because of the above paragraph, competitors forthwith their right to any legal redress against the organizing committee. All participants must ensure that their personal civil liability, individual accidents and medical insurance policies etc. are valid for the period of their activity.

All competitors, team leaders and officials will be informed as soon as possible if any alterations are made to the program.

These changes do not jeopardize the application of the international rules and regulations.

16. Code of conduct for horse welfare:

Considering that WAWE aims to meet the highest standards of equestrian competitions and therefore aspires at all times to defend horse welfare, we strongly recommend that at all times the following principles are achieved by anyone involved:


In all stages of the competition, during preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must prevail over any other demand.

Owners, trainers and judges have to be sure that horses and competitors must be fit and in good health before they are allowed to compete.

The events OC have to pay careful attention to the facilities, surrounding competition areas, ground surfaces, stabling, weather conditions, site safety and also to the horse's state of fitness before travelling at the end of the event.

WAWE urges anyone involved with equestrian sport to reach the highest level of training in their areas of expertise.
